

**TOWN OF BOW ISLAND
BYLAW 2000:09**

A Bylaw of the Town of Bow Island, in the province of Alberta to regulate the discharge and retail sale of fireworks.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Bow Island considers fireworks to be a possible fire hazard,

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Bow Island considers fireworks to be a possible danger to the safety and welfare of the public,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Bow Island in session duly assembled,
ENACTS as follows.

1. No person shall discharge, fire or set off fireworks within the municipal boundaries of the Town of Bow Island unless that person holds a permit for that purpose issued by the Fire Chief or other person authorized by the Fire Chief.
2. No person shall sell, offer for sale, or store for the purpose of sale fireworks unless that person holds a permit for that purpose issued by the Fire Chief or other person authorized by the Fire Chief.
3. The Fire Chief shall ensure that permits issued for the discharge of fireworks comply with the Alberta Fire Code 1997.
4. The Fire Chief shall ensure that permits issued for the sale of fire works comply with the Alberta Fire Code 1997.
5. This Bylaw repeals Bylaw 593..
